WHAT ARE WE DOING AND AIMING TO DO?

Field of Intervention: Demographic Changes: initiatives against **depopulation in remote areas**

Assumption: in the Alpine Region there is a **lack of qualified personnel** in these areas and professional fields (tourism, agriculture, services) and that young people are lacking information on jobs that might be in demand.

Project **aims** to:

- motivate young adults to stay or to return (**counterbalance of brain-drain**) after having finished their studies or vocational training outside the area
- increase the attractiveness of the labor market of Alpine rural areas by **establishing and maintaining attractive job opportunities**
- **match competences** (skills+knowledge+ «on the job» ability) required by supply (regional enterprises) and demand (job seekers such as those leaving the high school and university)
- find opportunities provided by “**Territorial Innovation Systems**” in terms of alternatives provided by not only formal (schools and vocational centres) but also not-formal and informal education (*see lifelong-, lifewide-, lifedeep- learning*) systems.

AGs EUSALP directly involved: AG3+AG6 (+AG7)

Key actors: **young adults (15-34)**, enterprises, vocational training centers and education institutions, local policy makers, other stakeholders

Methodology: 4 “Future Studies” approaches for an alternative/desirable future job opportunities (**target year 2030**) through new/innovative competences embedded in traditional and new/innovative activities


