



- Possible obstacles and possible actions to cope or anticipate them




Prepare on a whiteboard or flipchart a draft of a timeline with the steps: 2030, 2026, 2022, 2019




Briefly recall and share with participants the results from the previous WPs

Considering the main uncertainties used in the scenario building




Considering the local treasures and Iceberg model exercise

Specify the decision focus within the local framework


1. Identify the final outcome as desirable future 2030

«2030, everything is going well, I can see... »


- Ask the participants to visualize the desirable 2030 in terms of “visible” aspects, e.g. specific people doing specific activities, using specific things, within specific places, with particular infrastructures or facilities, etc.
- Write the shared definitions on a sticky note and put it at the end of the timeline



2. Identify the **conditions** at 2026 that make desired 2030 possible



3. Identify 1-2 **obstacles** in making the desirable 2030 possible by 2026 conditions and associated **possible actions to cope or anticipate** the mentioned obstacles




3. Repeat the previous instructions (for step 2) for the intermediate milestone **2022**


identify the **conditions** at 2022 that make desirable 2026 possible

identify 1-2 **2022 obstacles** in making the desirable 2026 possible


identify possible **2022 actions** to overcome the mentioned obstacles



Present and review (refining it) together the timeline, by answering the following questions:



- Do intermediate conditions well represents the key steps from the present to the final outcome?
- Do the defined obstacles and associated actions provide the framework for identifying concrete strategies?
