In order to better prepare WP5 activities be aware that your report shall also include:

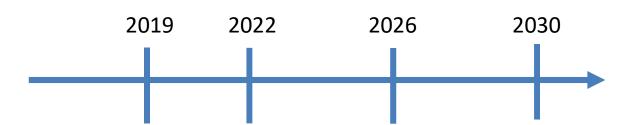
- Indication where the matching of the labor demand and offer is already successfully implemented
- How to progressively involve young, entrepreneurs, labor agencies, local policy makers and interest groups in developing sustainable innovations of the local social economic system
- How formal and/or non-formal and/or informal education system and vocational and educational training centers could match right skills and competences required within year 2030 by regional enterprises and job seekers







draw the timeline on a white/black board/flipchart







Identify the final outcome:

The final outcome (endpoint) is defined in plenary, must be shared and approved by all participants with local stakeholders, considering the local context).

Specific desirable conditions* (see next slide) at 2030 for labor demand and offer are:

*Suggestion



To identify desirable conditions at 2030 (in the STEP1) and the possible obstacles and opportunities (in the STEP2 and following ones) it can be helpful to take into consideration the factors of change: Social, Technological, Economic, Ecological, Political (STEEP)



First advice to Step 1



Make sure that participants think individually for a couple of minutes about the task of step 1.

Then let they discuss in group the issues of Step 1





Second advice to Step 1

If there are more than 6-7 participants, divide them in small groups (>3 people). Each groups will work separately on the same item: each outcome will draw a richer picture of the path to the desired futures



A strict rule



Participants shall face the exercise step by step.

Do not anticipate the next step!

Because of cognitive BIAS they have to discover each step backwards without thinking to the whole process!

Very important remark

How the present becomes a milestone:

Try to identify the conditions at 2019 that make possible the future that you want to want realized in 2022

Describe which actions the stakeholders could take NOW (i.e. during 2019) in order to let start the journey which will end with the desired 2030 (for labor demand and offer in your area)

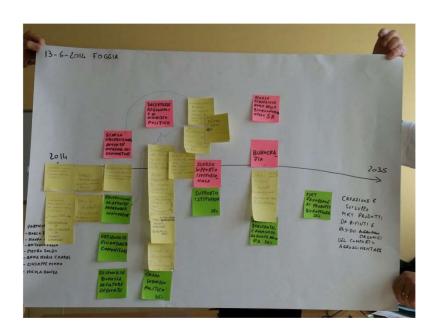
