

1.1 Summary of Local Development Strategy of LAG TOTI LAS

Local Development Strategy TOTI LAS is a result of the work of a wide range of stakeholders in the area of two municipalities, the Municipality of Maribor and the Kungota, which joined in local partnership TOTI LAS. The LAG area represents a completed geographical and functional unit, defined by common history, identical natural features and internal social cohesion.

Local Development Strategy TOTI LAS focuses primarily on the exploitation of the endogenous potentials of the area, which represent a good basis for the sustainable development of the area. It is prepared on the basis of needs, desires and expectations of the inhabitants of the area. The strategy is based on the following advantages and opportunities:

- quality and recognizable offer of diverse products (wine, fruit, honey and culinary), based on the natural features and tradition, well preserved and diverse natural and cultural heritage in connection with traditional events, possibilities for creating new (green) jobs link with agriculture (local self-sufficiency), tourism and nature conservation and sustainable use of natural resources, the development of civil society and the development of innovative forms of social economy.

Key principles that are reflected in the strategy: cooperation and stakeholder' integration, innovation and sustainability of solutions and social inclusion.

Strategic goal: Increasing employment opportunities, improving the development of the area, improve the quality of life and the attractiveness of the area and increase the social inclusion of vulnerable groups.

1.2 Definition of the area and population

The territory of TOTI LAS composed municipalities Maribor and Kungota as a complete entity and meets the criteria, necessary for successful joint local development. The municipality of Kungota was once part of a large city municipality Maribor and is still connected to it in the area of public administration, infrastructure, economy, daily migration, culture, education and many other areas.

The rural part of the Municipality of Maribor has the same characteristics as the settlements in the Municipality of Kungota. The population of these areas is facing the same problems, but also has development opportunities. Apart from everything else, we must not forget a very specific topics that closely connects both municipalities and offers unique opportunities for the development of the local community. In both municipalities it is developed and emphasized viticulture by culinary tradition. Also, the area is recognizable by many (also) international events: festivals, sports, cultural and ethnological events. In Maribor is growing the oldest vine grape in the world – STARA TRTA, one of the most attractive



tourist destination in Maribor, but in the settlement Špičnik / Svečina in the municipality of Kungota we can now be found an internationally recognized heart among vineyards, among locals known as "Dreisiebner's sweetheart."

1.2.1 General geographical characteristics of the TOTI LAS area

Municipality of Maribor

Maribor, which is the second largest city in Slovenia and the regional center, has a very favorable position on the crossroads of important European routes along the Drava River, between Pohorje, Kozjak and Slovenske gorice, between the Drava valley and Dravsko polje.

The advantage of the location is the good traffic (road and rail) connection of Maribor with the rest important cities such as Ljubljana, Zagreb and Graz. At the beginning of the 12th century, the area of today's Municipality of Maribor was part of the border area of the Franciscan countries. In order to control the entrance to the Drava valley before the Hungarian invasions, they are on today's Pyramid a castle, a castle that is first mentioned in document on October 20, 1164 as castrum Marchburch.

Today, Maribor is economic, financial, administrative, educational, cultural and commercial center of North-Eastern part of Slovenia with a number of institutions of national importance. Maribor is also university place. Prior to Slovenia's independence, Maribor was an economically developed city, which was a wave of bankruptcies a major blow to the market economy. Nowadays, the most of the city's income is brought by retailers activities and metal processing industry. In Maribor lives 111,842 inhabitants in the area of 147.5 km².

In the LEADER / CLLD area is the suburb of Maribor in the size of 109.85 km² and 16.504 inhabitants.*

Municipality of Kungota

The municipality of Kungota was founded in 1994 and lies in the hilly western part of Slovenske gorice. Sunny areas are covered with vineyards and orchards, plains with fields and forests.

In this rural municipality live on an area of 49 km² 4.793 inhabitants, most of them in rural areas, and a part in solid settlement.

It extends north of the city of Maribor and in the east it borders the municipalities of Šentilj and Pesnica, in the north at eighteen kilometers, with the Republic of Austria.

The settlement of Zg. Kungota is a natural center of the Upper Pesnica valley, which was formed at the junction of the stream and the Pesnica River. Zg. Kungota is the municipal center with central social

functions and the head of the municipal administration.

The main part of the economy of the municipality is agriculture (especially viticulture, fruit growing and some of livestock production) tourism, trade, other services and a smaller craft business activity. Recently, few new industrial enterprises and smaller companies have been established. The municipality itself is one of the less developed municipalities, most of the settlements lie in demographically endangered area. The public economic structure in the municipality is moderately developed.

The settlements of the Kungota Municipality are: Ciringa, Gradiška, Grušena, Jedlovnik, Jurski vrh, Kozjak nad Pesnico, Pesnica (in Kungota), Plač, Plintovec, Podigrac, Rošpoh (Kungota), Slatina (Kungota), Slatinski dol, Spodnje Vrtice, Svečina, Vršnik, Zg. Kungota, Zg. Vrtice, Špičnik.

1.2.2 TOTI LAS area


The area of the TOTI LAS Local Action Group covers the area of the Municipality Maribor and the Municipality of Kungota. Municipalities belong to the administrative unit Maribor and the administrative unit Pesnica.

The entire LAG area measures 196.5 km², representing 9.06% of the territory of the Podravje region, or 0.97% Slovenian territory (including the urban settlement Maribor).

There are 116,635 inhabitants (including the urban settlement of Maribor) throughout the LAG area. The urban settlement of Maribor, which has 95,338 inhabitants, is excluded from the LAG area. **The TOTI LAS area has, with an excluded urban settlement Maribor, 21,297 inhabitants.**

Picture 4: Location of TOTI LAS on the map Slovenia


2 Population in Slovenia, Podravska region and TOTI LAS

2.1 Population in Slovenia

Even though Slovenia is a relatively small country, it is divided into 12 statistical regions. Each region is unique, and almost each one stands out in some way or another. On the other hand, in many ways they are also similar. One in four residents of Slovenia was living in the Osrednjeslovenska statistical region, half of persons in employment living in the Zasavska statistical region were working outside the region. Most tourist arrivals were recorded in the Gorenjska statistical region, while most overnight stays were recorded in the Obalnokraška statistical region.




Population and area, statistical regions, 2016

Picture 5: Statistical regions – Slovenia*


Natural increase and net migration, 2016

2.2 Population Podravska region

The Podravska statistical region had 16% of Slovenia's population in 2016. The largest town in the region is Maribor. Its name comes from the Drava River and includes land on both banks along its course through Slovenia as well as the Pohorje mountains in the northeast of the region. The Drava is used for the production of hydroelectricity and the fertile land around it is used for agriculture. The share of job vacancies in all available jobs is among the highest in Slovenia and the region has a positive net migration rate but a very high natural decrease, which means an overall decrease in the population. The share of people aged 0–14 was the second lowest (13.6%). Compared to the previous year, in 2016 the population slightly decreased. The share of children born to unmarried mothers was among the highest (68%). The share of deaths before 65 years of age was the third highest in the country (19.6%). The share of people aged 25–64 years with tertiary education (25%) was below the national average and the share of students from the region studying in the Osrednjeslovenska statistical region was the lowest (21%).

As is shown in Table 1, the population in the Podravska region is slightly increased from 2008 to 2018. This can not be said for the municipalities of Maribor and Kungota where there is a noticeable trend of the outflow of the population, especially of the younger generations.

2.3 Population change, demographic balance Slovenia, statistical region Podravska, municipalities Kungota, Maribor

The natural increase of the population, in total and individually by sex, is not presented in the Podravska region, neither in the Municipality of Maribor from 2008 till today. In the municipality of Kungota, the natural decrease is more perceptible since 2016. The reason is the bankruptcy of a number of metal processing industries in Maribor in the nineties, where a large number of residents from nearby and distant municipalities of north-eastern Slovenia were employed. Likewise, the last economic crisis had an impact on the emigration in the region and in both municipalities of TOTI LAS.

Live births are decreasing from the year 2008 in Slovenia as well in region Podravska and in Kungota and Maribor.

Table 4 shows the basic population groups in Slovenia and statistical region Podravska from the year 2008 till first part of 2018. 94% of Slovenes and 6% of foreigners live in Slovenia, while 95% of Slovene residents and 5% of foreigners live in the Podravska region. The share of women is slightly higher among the domestic population, while among the foreigners the male sex is dominant. Since 2008, there has been a slight increase in foreign population by about 2%, that is, labor migrations from the former Yugoslav countries.

The table 5 and 6 shows mean age, Ageing index, Proportion of population aged 0-14 (%), 15-64 (%), 65 or more (%), 80 or more (%), Age dependency ratio, Young-age dependency ratio, Old-age dependency ratio per sex in Slovenia, Region Podravska, Municipalities Kungota and Maribor.

The mean age in Slovenia ranges from 41 years in year 2012 and in 2018 the 43 year (total men and women). In the Podravska region, the mean age was 42 years in 2012 and 44 years in 2018. The age index is increasing, in Slovenia in 2012 it was 117,3 in 2018 127, and in the Podravska region in 2012 total of 134.7 , and 146 in 2018.

The mean age on municipalities level is more or less the same as on national and regional level. Much higher was age index, in total 111,1 in Kungota in 2012, in 2018 is 141. In Maribor it was 175,3 in total in

2012 in 2018 is 215 (table 7).





3 Local Economy

The economy of the Podravska Region is dominated by the service industry, which represents about 60% of the overall structure. Only 25 years ago the Podravska Region enjoyed the reputation of a strong industrial region due to long industrial tradition. The region has all the attributes required for production of sophisticated products. Most companies are in the processing industries such as metal-processing, chemicals and food & beverages. There is also water wealth that is used for electricity production (the chain of hydro-electric power plants on the Drava River). In the region Podravska the unemployment rate (9.0%) was higher than the national average (8.0%). The region generated 12.8% of the national GDP, but GDP per capita was the fifth lowest in the country. The region had slightly more than 26,100 enterprises with on average 4.5 persons employed. In 2016, 516 dwellings were completed, of which almost 80% new ones. In the Podravska statistical region around 579,800 overnight stays were generated in 2016, about two thirds by foreign tourists. 13% of foreign overnight stays were generated by tourists from Germany. There were 10,990 agricultural holdings and on average 7.2 hectares of utilised agricultural area per agricultural holding.

The wide area surrounding the river Drava is the Podravska region. Historical points of interest, relaxing thermal spas, wines and food are synonyms of Podravska. The whole region of Podravska is in a tight relationship with river Drava. Despite being the second largest city of Slovenia, Maribor keeps its lovely charms – on one side are the beautiful Pohorje mountains as a ski center and on the other side, are the delightful wine-growing hills. In Lent, the oldest part of Maribor, is the famous Guinness record holder: Stara trta, known as the World's oldest vine. Many water sports are practiced along the river Drava.

Podravska is an important wine-producing region of Slovenia. The vineyards are mainly situated in Haloze hills where many wine roads start. Between Slovenske gorice and Haloze is the oldest city of Slovenia, Ptuj. Its settlement dates from the Stone Age. The whole city is a historical and cultural heritage site.

The average duration the region in 2017 is 1.86 days. Region is offering SPA centers, good culinary and wines, festivals, summer and winter sport activities, hiking, bicycling, adrenaline parks, natural parks, a lot of farm tourisms,...



4 Jobs

4.1 Employment

In Slovenia, in the year 2017 23% of persons were employed in Manufacturing, follows 13% in Wholesale and retail trade, repair of motor vehicles and motorcycles, 8% in Education, 7% Human health and social work activities, 6,25% Professional, scientific and technical activities, 5,95% Transportation and storage, 3% Agriculture, forestry and fishing, 2,51% Financial and insurance activities,... (Table 11).



5.2 Unemployment rates by sex, age and citizens

In the last quarter of 2017 there were 60,000 unemployed persons in Slovenia, 26,5% (21.000) less than a year ago. Among unemployed there were 46,8% men and 53,2% women. For the first time after the 2nd quarter of 2009 (when it stood at 5.6%) the ILO unemployment rate was below 6%, i.e. 5.8%. Among young persons (15 – 29-year-olds) the unemployment rate was 9,7% (6.5 percentage points lower than a year ago), while among older persons (50 – 64-year-olds) it was 4.9% (2.1 percentage points lower than in the last quarter of 2016). In the 4th quarter of 2017 the employment rate was 55,4%, 2,8 percentage points higher than a year ago. The activity rate was 58,8%, 1,6 percentage points higher than in the previous year.
